



Do you have the time and the gifts to represent this community?

CELL Big Local is looking for people to sit on the **CELL Partnership** to oversee our Big Local Plan.

For the past 2 years, a number of dedicated volunteers have given their time to sit on the Steering Group, lead the consultations, organise the events and get us to this point. Some of these people will be standing for re-election, but there is also an opportunity **NOW** for others to offer their services.

How? By submitting your nomination, whether of yourself or someone else, by email to enquiries@cell-biglocal.org.uk. Forms are available on the CELL biglocal website in the public documents section (or available from Lynemouth Resource Centre). If nominating someone else you must get their permission to stand. Nominees need to submit a form by Monday 2nd February 2015 explaining why they should be considered for election. This information will be posted on the website and also on display at the election.

When can people vote? At our Cell Big Local steering committee meeting at 7pm on Monday 9th February 2015 at Cresswell Village Hall.

Who is eligible to stand and to vote? All those resident in the Cell area or working or volunteering full-time in the area.

What is the purpose of the Partnership Executive Committee? To oversee the BigLocal Plan for spending £1million and its delivery; to arrange all necessary events and administration to support this; to be answerable to BigLocal Residents and to the Local Trust. Partnership Committee members stand for a 2 year period of service.

What sort of skills are needed? Do you have any of these? Passion for change in the community/administration skills/ creativity/ financial understanding / event planning/ community development / marketing or publicity skills? Then maybe we need you to join us!

What sort of commitment is required for the Partnership Committee?

This is a serious commitment. There are likely to be meetings once a month, and there may be occasional sub committees to attend, and some duties according to your role on the Partnership Committee. Time commitment is likely to be in the region of between 3-5 hours per month.
